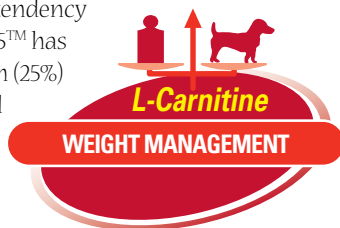

Weight Management

Cocker Spaniels have a natural tendency to gain weight. Cocker Spaniel 25™ has controlled fat (12.5%) and protein (25%) levels to help prevent additional weight gain. As well, the addition of L-carnitine (100 mg/kg), helps to burn fat reserves and maintain lean muscle mass. Additionally, the unique "cashew" shaped kibble as well as the kibble size, texture and low density significantly slow down eating and keep Cocker Spaniels feeling fuller, longer.

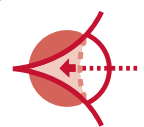
Nourishes Coat Beauty

The Cocker Spaniel is known for its silky coat, however, they can also be subject to greasy skin and dandruff. An appropriate diet is necessary to ensure that they maintain healthy skin and a shiny coat. Omega 3 & 6 essential fatty acids help to promote a beautiful, shiny coat while chelated copper, biotin and tyrosine help intensify coat color.



Protects Sensitive Ears

The skin in and around the Cocker Spaniel's ears needs special care. Skin irritation can be caused by a deficiency of vitamin A in the diet. The size and shape of their ears can also contribute to skin infections by preventing inadequate airflow. A patented blend of 4 B-vitamins & 1 amino acid, selenium and omega 3 fatty acids and very high levels of vitamin A help to keep the skin cells surrounding the ears healthy by building up a strong skin barrier.



Healthy Eyes

Cocker Spaniels have longer life spans than most MEDIUM breed dogs, and they are twice as likely to suffer from cataracts. High levels of antioxidants like vitamin E (600 IU/kg) & C (300 mg/kg), green tea polyphenols (150 mg/kg), along with lutein (5 mg/kg), taurine, carnitine and arginine help to promote healthy vision.
